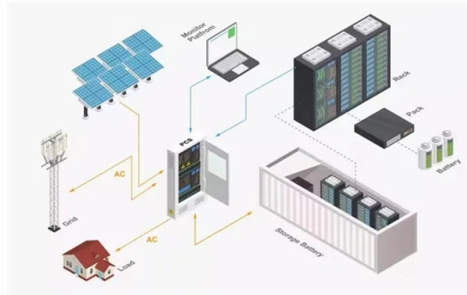

In fused biconical taper (FBT) couplers, fibers are heated and stretched until their cores are in close proximity for light transfer. These regions are fragile and susceptible to breakage. Clamps provide mechanical support, reducing stress on the fused section and preventing fiber breakage during installation or operation.
