

Grounding of communication tower feet



Overview

Grounding electrodes should be spaced by a minimum of 6'. The ideal minimum spacing is 2X ground rod length. Each grounding electrode should be connected via a ground ring comprised of either (1) #2 AWG minimum bare tinned solid copper wire or (2) 1/0 AWG minimum bare tinned. The fundamental objective of this document is to provide guidelines and practices for Ericsson site equipment grounding, with recommended methods that are essential to protect personnel, minimize component failure, and optimize performance by reducing electrical noise.
