

Grounding requirements for flexible wire distribution boxes



Article Overview

Flexible wire distribution boxes must maintain a continuous, low-impedance grounding path using equipment grounding conductors, pigtails, and proper bonding to ensure safety and NEC compliance.

Key Grounding Principles

- Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC)
 - The EGC provides a safe, low-impedance path for fault current to return to the source, allowing overcurrent protective devices to trip quickly in case of a ground fault ().
 - All incoming and outgoing EGCs must remain continuously connected, even if a device is removed for maintenance or replacement ().
- Pigtail Connections
 - To maintain continuity, all EGCs in a box are spliced together with a short jumper wire (pigtail) that connects to the device's grounding terminal ().
 - This ensures that removing a switch or receptacle does not interrupt the grounding path.
- Metallic Boxes
 - Metal boxes must be bonded to the EGC system using a dedicated green grounding screw, grounding clip, or listed lug ().
 - Self-grounding devices can eliminate the need for a separate pigtail if they make reliable contact with the bonded metal box....
