

Height requirements for high-voltage distribution boxes



Article Overview

High-voltage distribution boxes should be installed at safe, accessible heights and designed according to IEC and national standards, with dimensions ensuring proper clearance, component layout, and protection.

Installation Height

For wall-mounted or outdoor high-voltage distribution boxes, the recommended installation heights are:

- Indoor wall-mounted boxes: 4.5 to 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) from the floor to the center of the box for easy accessibility without bending or stretching .
- Outdoor boxes: At least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above ground to prevent water ingress and dirt accumulation .
- Ground-mounted boxes: Raised 2 to 4 inches (5-10 cm) above the ground to avoid moisture damage . These heights ensure safe operation, convenient maintenance, and compliance with standards such as BS 7671 and IEC 60364-5-52 .
