

How are pigtail specifications expressed



Article Overview

Fiber optic pigtail specifications are expressed through a combination of fiber type, connector type, polish type, ferrule material, insertion loss, return loss, mechanical and environmental parameters, and color coding.

Key Specification Parameters

1. Fiber Type: Pigtails are specified by the type of optical fiber used, such as single-mode (OS1/OS2) or multimode (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5), which determines bandwidth, attenuation, and application suitability . 2. Connector Type: The factory-terminated end is defined by the connector type, such as LC, SC, ST, MU, or MTP/MPO, which affects compatibility with equipment and patch panels . 3. Polish Type: The connector end is polished to reduce reflection and insertion loss. Common polish types include UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) and APC (Angled Physical Contact), with APC providing lower back reflection . 4. Ferrule Material: The ferrule, which aligns the fiber in the connector, is typically made of ceramic, stainless steel, or polymer, influencing durability and precision . 5. Optical Performance:

- Insertion Loss (IL): The amount of signal loss introduced by the pigtail, usually expressed in dB.
- Return Loss (RL): The amount of reflected signal, also in dB, critical for high-speed or long-distance applications . 6. Mechanical and Environmental Parameters:
 - Tensile Strength: Maximum pulling force the pigtail can withstand.
 - Operating Temperature Range: Specifies the temperature limits for reliable performance.
 - Cable Construction: Tight-buffered or loose-tube, sometimes armored for outdoor...
