

How long is a fiber optic cable channel

The length of a fiber optic cable channel varies widely, from a few meters for multimode cables in data centers to over 100 kilometers for single-mode long-distance links.

General Fiber Optic Cable Distances

Fiber optic cable transmission distance depends on attenuation (signal loss over distance) and dispersion (signal spreading over time), which affect signal quality and data integrity .

- Multimode fiber is typically used for short distances, such as within buildings or data centers. Depending on the cable type and network speed:
 - OM1: up to 275 meters at 1 Gbps, 33 meters at 10 Gbps
 - OM2: up to 550 meters at 1 Gbps, 82 meters at 10 Gbps
 - OM3/OM4: up to 300-400 meters at 10 Gbps, 100-150 meters at 40-100 Gbps
- Single-mode fiber is used for long-distance applications. It can transmit signals over 10 km to 100+ km without amplification, and with optical amplifiers, distances can extend to thousands of kilometers, such as in submarine cables .
