

How many cores of cable should be used in a secondary distribution box

The number of cable cores in a secondary distribution box depends on the system type, load balance, and safety requirements, typically ranging from 2 to 5 cores.

General Guidelines

- **Single-Core Cable:** Contains one conductor, usually used for long lines, high-current circuits, or DC power supply circuits where single-core cables are more practical .
- **Two-Core Cable:** One phase and one neutral, commonly used in single-phase systems where the neutral and protective conductor may share the same line .
- **Three-Core Cable:** Used for three-phase systems without a neutral or for single-phase systems with a separate earth conductor .
- **Four-Core Cable:** Three-phase plus neutral, suitable for balanced three-phase loads. The fourth core can also carry unbalanced or short-circuit currents, typically sized at least half of the phase conductor .
- **Five-Core Cable:** Three-phase plus neutral and protective earth, standard for unbalanced three-phase systems or where independent PE and neutral lines are required. This configuration is often used in low-voltage distribution systems with higher safety requirements .

Selection Considerations

- **System Type:** Determine whether the system is single-phase or three-phase, and whether it is balanced or unbalanced .
- **Load Balance:** For balanced three-phase loads, a 3-core cable may suffice. For un...
