A standard optical module typically connects to one or two network cables, but high-density MPO modules can connect to 8, 12, 16, 24, or even 32 fibers in a single connector.

Standard SFP and SFP+ Modules

Most SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) modules use LC connectors, which are duplex, meaning they connect two fiber cables—one for transmitting and one for receiving data. Single-mode or multi-mode SFP modules generally follow this duplex configuration, so a single module interfaces with one pair of fibers. In WDM (Wavelength Division Multiplexing) modules, a single fiber can carry both transmit and receive signals at different wavelengths, effectively reducing the number of fibers to one per module.

High-Density MPO/MTP Modules

For high-speed or high-density applications, such as 100G or 400G networks, MPO (Multi-Fiber Push-On) connectors are used. These modules can terminate multiple fibers in a single rectangular ferrule, allowing a single optical module to connect to 8, 12, 16, 24, or 32 fibers. MPO modules are commonly used in parallel optics setups, where multiple fibers transmit and receive data simultaneously, significantly increasing port density and reducing cabling complexity....
