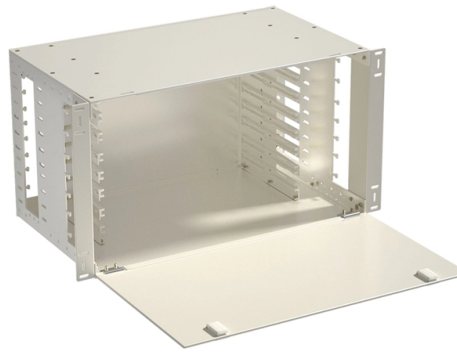


How many volts is the public distribution box

A public distribution box typically handles medium-voltage electricity ranging from 4,000 to 35,000 volts, which is stepped down to 120/240 volts for residential use.

Medium-Voltage Distribution

The public distribution box, often part of a neighborhood or street-level distribution system, receives electricity from substations at medium-voltage levels, usually between 4 kV and 35 kV, with common residential distribution voltages being 7.2 kV or 12.47 kV in many areas . These voltages are necessary to efficiently transmit power over distances while minimizing energy loss.

Step-Down to Low Voltage

Before electricity enters homes or businesses, a distribution transformer connected to the distribution box reduces the medium voltage to a low-voltage secondary circuit, typically 120/240 volts AC in North America . This low-voltage output is what powers standard household appliances and lighting.

Safety Considerations

Medium-voltage lines in distribution boxes are considered high-voltage (above 600 V) and can be extremely dangerous. Only trained professionals should work near or on these boxes, as contact with these voltages can cause severe injury or death . The l...
