

How should the quota be applied to cable tray supports



Article Overview

Cable tray supports should be spaced according to the tray type, load, and installation standards, typically ranging from 1.5 to 3 meters, following IEC 61537 or equivalent national standards.

Support Spacing Guidelines

The spacing of cable tray supports, often referred to as the "quota," depends on several factors including the type of tray, material, load of cables, and environmental conditions. For standard installations:

- Straight steel or aluminum trays: Support spacing is commonly 2 to 3 meters for light to medium loads, while heavier loads may require closer spacing around 1.5 meters .
- Mesh or ventilated trays: These may require shorter support intervals due to reduced structural rigidity .
- Elbows, tees, and bends: Special consideration is needed as loads are uneven; supports should be placed closer to these points to maintain stability .

Calculation Method

A practical formula to determine the number of supports is: $\text{Support Quantity} = \frac{\text{Total Tray Length}}{\text{Support Spacing}} + 1$ For example, a 20-meter tray with 2-meter spacing requires: $20 \div 2 + 1 = 11$ supports, including both ends
