

How thick is the pigtail cable in the low-voltage distribution box



Article Overview

Pigtail cables in low-voltage distribution boxes typically use conductors with cross-sections ranging from 1.5 mm² to 16 mm², depending on current rating, with insulation thickness varying by voltage and material type.

Conductor Cross-Section

The thickness of the pigtail cable is primarily determined by the conductor cross-section, which is selected based on the current it must carry and the installation conditions. In low-voltage distribution boxes (0.6/1 kV systems), typical pigtail conductors are:

- 1.5 mm² to 2.5 mm² for control, signaling, or small branch circuits
 - 4 mm² to 16 mm² for main feeders or higher-current connections
- The exact choice depends on the load, short-circuit protection, and panel design. IEC 60364-5-52 provides guidance for minimum cross-sections, and manufacturers often specify the recommended conductor size for internal wiring.

Insulation Thickness

The insulation thickness of LV pigtail cables depends on the voltage rating and the type of insulation material:

- XLPE (cross-linked polyethylene) insulation allows thinner layers due to higher dielectric strength.
