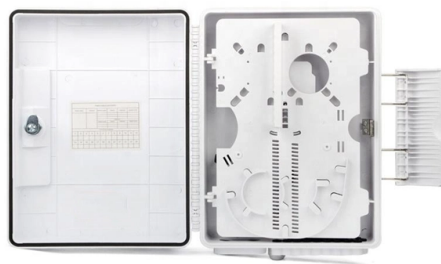


How to connect a pigtail jumper cable

A fiber optic pigtail is connected to a jumper cable using a terminal box and a coupler, with the pigtail's bare end fusion-spliced to the optical cable and the connectorized end plugged into the jumper via the coupler.

Detailed Explanation

Pigtail Overview: A pigtail is a short fiber optic cable with a factory-polished connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The bare end is designed to be permanently spliced to the optical fiber in a cable, while the connectorized end allows for easy connection to other devices or jumper cables . **Jumper Cable Overview:** A jumper cable, also called a patch cord, has connectors on both ends and is used for flexible, reconfigurable connections between devices, optical distribution frames (ODFs), or terminal boxes . **Connection Process:**

- **Fusion Splicing:** The bare end of the pigtail is fusion-spliced to the optical fiber inside a terminal box or optical distribution frame. This creates a permanent, low-loss connection between the main fiber and the pigtail .
 - **Terminal Box and Coupler:** The connectorized end of the pigtail is inserted into a fiber optic coupler (adapter) inside the terminal box. The coupler allows a movable, detachable connection between the pigtail and the jumper cable .
 - **Jumper Connection:** The jumper cable is then plugged into the coupler, completing the optical path from the device to the fiber network. This setup allows for easy maintenance and reconfiguration without disturbing the spliced fibers .
