 - Splitters can be configured in ratios like 1:2, 1:4, 1:8, or higher, depending on the number of endpoints required.
- Using a 288-Core Joint Box
 - A 288-core joint box allows the cable to be terminated and distributed into multiple smaller fiber runs while maintaining organization and protection.
 - This method is space-efficient, scalable, and cost-effective, ideal for large-scale n...
