

# How to divide indoor optical cables

Indoor optical cables are divided using fiber optic splitters, which split a single optical signal into multiple outputs for distribution to different devices or rooms.

### Understanding Optical Splitters

An optical splitter is a passive device that divides one incoming optical signal into two or more outgoing signals without requiring power, making it ideal for indoor installations. Splitters come in various configurations, such as 1×2, 1×4, 1×8, or 1×32, depending on the number of outputs needed. They can be installed in patch panels, wall boxes, or distribution frames.

### Steps to Divide Indoor Optical Cables

- **Identify the Main Fiber Line** Locate the main fiber optic cable entering your home or building. This is typically connected to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or a central distribution point.
- **Connect the Splitter Input** Insert the main fiber cable into the input port of the fiber optic splitter. Ensure the connector type (SC, LC, or APC) matches the splitter.
- **Connect Splitter Outputs** Use fiber patch cables to connect the output ports of the splitter to the devices or secondary splitters. For example, a 1×2 splitter allows you to connect two receivers or routers.
- **Cascading Splitters (Optional)** If more outputs are needed, you can connect a secondary splitter to one of the outputs of the primary splitter. Be mindful that each splitter introduces signal loss, typically around 3.5 dB for a 1×2 splitter, so limit cascading to 2-3 levels to maintain signal quality.
- **Secure and Test Connections** Mount the splitter in a safe, dry location such as a w...
