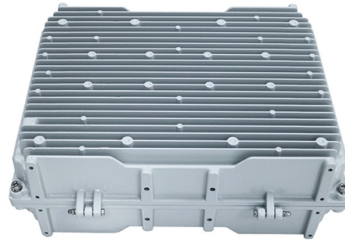


How to modify the connector of armored optical cable

Modifying armored optical cable connectors requires careful handling, proper tools, and understanding of armored cable construction to maintain signal integrity and durability.

Understanding Armored Fiber Cables

Armored fiber optic cables are reinforced with steel, aluminum, or Kevlar layers to resist crushing, bending, moisture, and rodent damage, making them heavier and stiffer than standard fiber cables (). The armor surrounds the fiber core and strength members, which protect the optical fibers from mechanical stress. This construction means that any modification to connectors must account for the additional protective layers and the cable's larger minimum bend radius ().

Connector Types and Considerations

Armored cables can be terminated with various connectors such as LC, SC, ST, FC, SMA, or 2.5 mm ferrules (). When modifying connectors:

- Ensure the new connector is compatible with the fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and core diameter.
- Maintain proper polarity and alignment to prevent signal loss.
- Use factory-terminated pigtails when possible for precision, then splice to the armored cable in the field ()....
