Dust caps should always be used whenever a fiber optic connector is not actively in use.

Cleaning and Handling Practices

Even with dust caps, proper cleaning and handling are critical. Small dust particles or oil deposits on fiber surfaces can reduce light transmission and damage optical components over time. Recommended practices include:

- Avoid touching the fiber end with fingers or any surface to prevent contamination.
- Use Clean Dry Air (CDA) or filtered compressed air to remove loose particles before connecting fibers.
- Clean with lens tissue and spectroscopic-grade solvents like methanol or isopropyl...
