

I don't want to put the router in the fiber optic box



Overview

The typical solution is install the fiber modem in the best place for the fiber, and then run a single ethernet line to your router. If it's an all-in-one box you can probably get it changed. Otherwise, you must install expensive fiber cabling, ONT, and fiber routers to access an optical fiber internet connection. It converts incoming high-speed optical signals into. How do I effectively "put" the four ports in my living room if moving the modem isn't an option?

Thanks! The basic problem with installing fiber is it's glass, and glass doesn't bend well. That thin white fiber cable has a minimum bend radius of somewhere around 10 cm, so if you pull it tight. During your fiber-optic installation, your technician will need outdoor and indoor access to where you want to plug in your router. I asked if I could turn it off and they told me "no, just use your own wifi router if you don't want to use ours. " Which I get it, but I'd rather not have that interference.



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My ISP said that with their fiber modem, it comes with Wifi, which I definitely don't want. I asked if I could turn it off and they told me "no, just use your own wifi router if you don't want to use ours."

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The short answer: you don't need a modem, you need an ONT — and your fiber provider will supply it. The router is where your purchasing decision actually matters, because it's the piece of ...
