Voltage and Current Rating: The incoming cable must match the distribution box's rated voltage and the expected load current. Low-voltage distribution boxes typically use cables rated for 230/400V AC in single-phase or three-phase systems . The cable size should be calculated to handle the maximum load without excessive voltage drop. **Cable Type:** Commonly used cables include PVC-insulated copper or aluminum conductors for low-voltage applications. For industrial or outdoor installations, XLPE-insulated cables may be preferred for higher thermal and mechanical resistance . **Short-Circuit and Fault Current:** The cable must withstand the maximum prospective short-circuit current at the distribution box terminals. This ensures that protective devices such as MCBs, MCCBs, or fuses can operate safely without damaging the cable . **Standards Compliance:** Selection should follow relevant standards such as IEC 61439, IEC 60898, IEC 61008/61009, BS 7671, or NEC depending on the region. These standards define insulation, conductor sizing, and installation practices . **Installation Considerations:**

- Ensure proper cable entry and termination in the distribution box to avoid mechanical stress....
