Indoor electrical distribution boxes should be raised above the ground, typically around 1.2 to 1.5 meters, to ensure safety, accessibility, and compliance with standards.

Recommended Height

For indoor installations, the bottom of a wall-mounted distribution box is generally recommended to be between 1.2 meters and 1.5 meters (approximately 4 to 5 feet) above the floor. This height allows operators to comfortably perform routine maintenance, read labels, operate switches, and inspect circuits without bending or stretching excessively, while keeping the box out of reach of children. In residential settings, a height of around 1.5 meters is commonly used to balance accessibility and safety.

Safety and Accessibility Considerations

- **Moisture Protection:** Raising the box above the floor helps prevent damage from water, spills, or minor flooding, which is particularly important in basements or areas prone to dampness.
- **Ergonomics:** Proper height ensures that maintenance tasks such as switch operation, circuit inspection, and instrument reading can be performed comfortably.
- **Clearances:** Adequate working space around the box is essential. A minimum of 3 feet of front clearance and 30 inches from the sides is recommended to allow safe o...

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In the same vein, the height of the electrical panel must not be more than six feet seven inches from the ground. The
