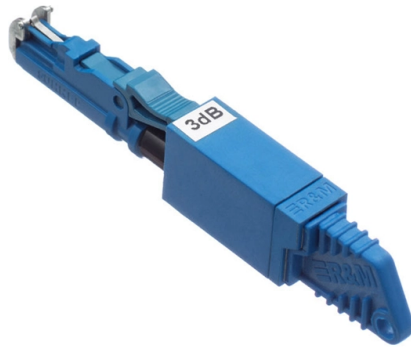


Installation Regulations for Wall-Mounted Electrical Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Wall-mounted electrical distribution boxes must be installed at accessible heights, in dry and ventilated locations, with proper grounding, protection devices, and compliance with NEC and IEC standards.

Placement and Height

Wall-mounted boxes should be installed between 4.5 and 5.5 feet (1.37–1.68 m) above the floor for easy access without bending or stretching, while outdoor boxes should be at least 3 feet above ground to avoid water and dirt exposure (). Ensure the location is dry, well-ventilated, and free from hazards such as fire, water, or mechanical damage (). Maintain clear working space in front of the box, typically 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high as per NEC 110.26 ().

Enclosure and Protection

Select a box with the appropriate IP or NEMA rating based on environmental conditions. For indoor use, IP20–IP44 may suffice, while outdoor or washdown areas require IP66, IP67, or IP69K for high-pressure cleaning or corrosive environments (). Boxes are typically made of steel for durability or plastic for lighter indoor applications ().
