

Installation Requirements for Cable Trays in Low-Voltage Electrical Shafts



Article Overview

Proper installation of cable trays in low-voltage shafts requires adherence to support spans, material selection, cable fill limits, routing, and safety standards to ensure compliance and system reliability.

Support Span and Mounting

Cable trays must be supported at intervals determined by the manufacturer's load capacity and the total anticipated weight of the cables. Common support methods include trapeze hangers for ceiling suspensions and cantilever wall brackets for vertical runs along walls. The support span must prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity, and all supports should be installed by competent personnel familiar with electrical installation practices .

Material Selection

Cable trays are typically made from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, with finishes such as galvanization or powder coating to resist corrosion. Stainless steel (e.g., AISI 316L) is preferred in corrosive environments, while aluminum offers lightweight and corrosion-resistant properties. The choice of material depends on environmental conditions, mechanical load, and potential exposure to moisture or chemicals .
