

Installation Standards for 35mm Cables in Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

35mm² cables in distribution boxes must be installed following proper sizing, insulation, grounding, spacing, and protection standards to ensure safety, compliance, and long-term reliability.

Cable Sizing and Selection

For 35mm² cables, ensure the conductor material (typically copper or aluminum) and insulation type (PVC, XLPE, or thermosetting) are suitable for the intended current load and voltage rating. The cable must comply with IEC 60364, NEC, or local wiring regulations, which define current-carrying capacity, voltage drop limits, and thermal ratings. Use UL/CE-certified cables to meet safety and performance standards.

Routing and Placement

- Install cables in dry, accessible areas with adequate ventilation to prevent overheating.
- Maintain neat cable management using cable ties, channels, or trays to avoid crossing or tangling, which reduces the risk of short circuits and simplifies maintenance.
- Leave sufficient air gaps around cables to allow heat dissipation, especially in high-current circuits.
