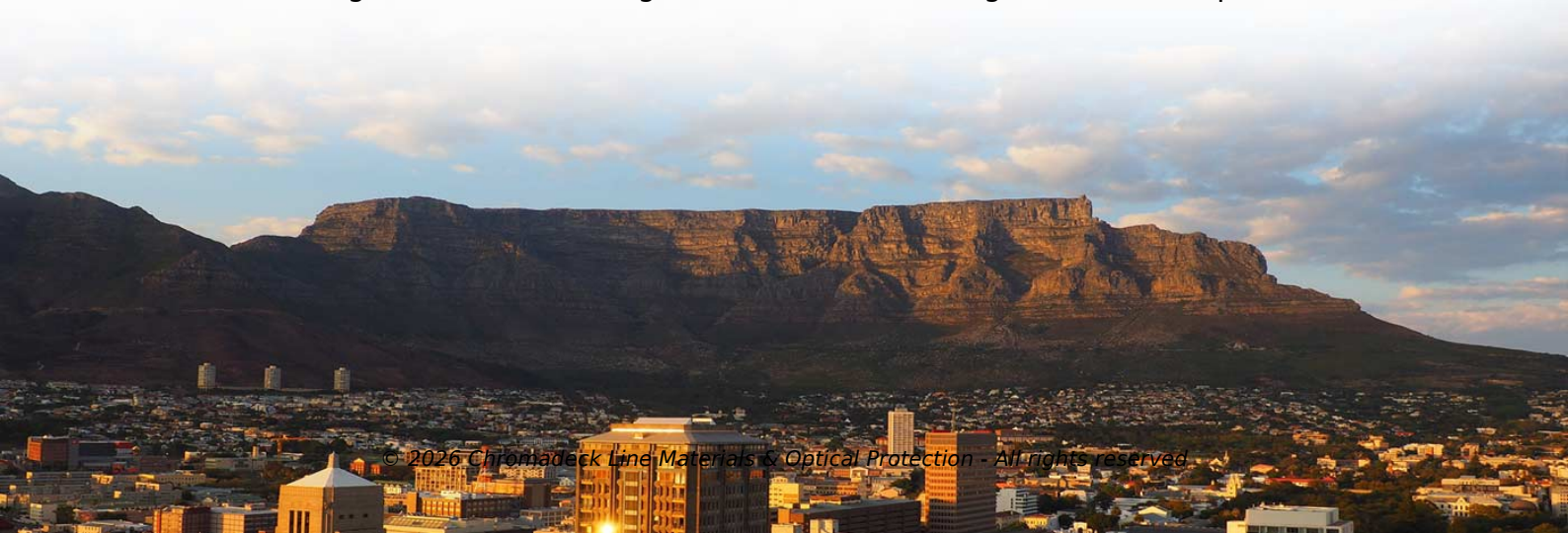


Integration of outdoor optical cables by telecommunications companies in the Democratic Republic of Congo
