

Is 12dB normal for fiber optic metering



Overview

Engineers use the decibel-milliwatt (dBm) to quantify the absolute power level of the optical signal on a logarithmic scale, referencing it to one milliwatt (mW). This scale allows for the easy measurement and comparison of the vast range of power levels encountered in fiber networks, from the. Instruments that measure in dB can be either optical power meters or optical loss test sets (OLTS). While most power meters have ranges of +3 to -50 dBm, most sources are. Is dB the same as dBm?

No. Can insertion loss be measured in dBm?

No. When power is measured in linear units (mW, uW or nW), dB is calculated on a log scale using this formula: Thus $1 \text{ mW} = 0 \text{ dBm}$, $1 \text{ uW} = -30 \text{ dBm}$, $1 \text{ nW} = -60 \text{ dBm}$ and two equal powers compared are 0dB (eg. 8 percent of lost optical power).
