

Is a box-type or a linear type of beam splitter better

Cube (box-type) beam splitters are generally better for minimizing ghosting and maintaining equal optical path lengths, while plate (linear-type) beam splitters are lighter, more compact, and cost-effective.

Cube (Box-Type) Beam Splitters

Cube beam splitters are constructed by cementing or optically contacting two right-angle prisms, with a partially reflective coating on the hypotenuse of one prism .

Advantages:

- Equal optical path lengths for transmitted and reflected beams, which is critical in interferometry .
 - Minimal ghosting, as the cubic design prevents multiple back-surface reflections .
 - High polarization purity when using polarizing cube designs, with extinction ratios often exceeding 1000:1 .
 - Durability: Optically contacted cubes can handle higher laser power densities compared to cemented plates .
- Disadvantages:
- Heavier and bulkier than plate splitters, which may be a limitation in compact setups .
 - Higher cost due to more complex manufacturing and materials .
 - Sensitive to beam convergence/divergence; cubes work best with collimated beams
