

Is fiber optic transmission safe

Fiber optic communication is generally safe for public use, posing no radiation or electromagnetic hazards, though physical and chemical precautions are necessary during installation and maintenance.

Health and Radiation Safety

Fiber optic cables transmit data using light signals through glass or plastic fibers, not electrical currents, which means they do not emit electromagnetic radiation like copper cables or wireless devices . The light is contained within the fiber core through total internal reflection, preventing exposure to surrounding areas . The signals are typically in the infrared spectrum, which is non-ionizing and does not penetrate deeply into the body, making it safe for humans . Public health organizations recommend fiber optics over wireless technologies due to this safety advantage .

Physical Hazards

While fiber optics are safe for general use, technicians handling the cables face specific risks. The glass fibers can produce microscopic shards if cut or broken, which can puncture the skin, cause irritation, or, if inhaled or ingested, lead to internal injuries . Proper disposal, clean work areas, and protective equipment are essential to prevent accidents. Additionally, the infrared light used in transmission is invisible, so direct exposure to active fibers can damage the eyes if safety precautions are not followed .
