Yes, optical fiber is a type of wired (guided) transmission medium that transmits data using light signals through a physical cable.

Optical fiber is classified as a guided or wired transmission medium because it relies on a physical path—typically a glass or plastic core surrounded by cladding—to transmit data signals in the form of light . Unlike wireless media, where signals propagate through air or space, optical fiber confines the light within the core using total internal reflection, ensuring controlled and secure communication between devices .

Characteristics of Optical Fiber

- **High Bandwidth and Speed:** Optical fibers can carry very large volumes of data at extremely high speeds, supporting tens or hundreds of gigabits per second .
- **Long-Distance Transmission:** Low signal attenuation allows data to travel long distances without frequent repeaters, making it ideal for backbone networks and undersea cables .
- **Immunity to Electromagnetic Interference:** Unlike copper cables, optical fibers are not affected by EMI or electrical noise, providing reliable communication in harsh environments .
- **Physical Structure:** The core of the fiber is made of highly refined glass or plastic, surrounded by cladding with a lower refractive index to confine light
