Explanation

In 40GBASE-SR4 QSFP+ transceivers, the MPO (or MTP) interface is standardized as a male connector, which features protruding alignment pins and plugs designed to fit into a female connector. The female connector, in contrast, has recessed sockets to receive the male pins, ensuring a secure and proper connection. When connecting a 40G QSFP+ SR4 transceiver to a fiber network, the pigtail or trunk cable must have female MPO connectors on the ends that mate with the transceiver. This is necessary because male-to-male connections are not compatible, and the female connector ensures proper alignment of the fibers for both transmit (TX) and receive (RX) channels.
