An FC interface network cable uses a Fibre Channel protocol over fiber optic or copper cabling, typically terminated with an FC (Ferrule Connector) for high-speed, reliable data transmission.

Overview of Fibre Channel (FC) Networks

Fibre Channel is a high-speed data transfer protocol primarily used to connect servers to storage systems in Storage Area Networks (SANs). It ensures in-order, lossless delivery of block data and supports data rates from 1 Gbps up to 128 Gbps, depending on the technology generation . FC networks usually form a switched fabric, where multiple switches operate together as a single network, providing redundancy and high throughput . While originally designed for optical fiber, FC can also run over copper cabling .

FC Connectors

The FC connector is a fiber-optic connector with a threaded, round metal body designed for secure connections in high-vibration environments . Key features include:

- Ferrule Diameter: 2.5 mm, typically made of zirconia ceramic or stainless steel .
- Polish Types: FC/PC (Physical Contact), FC/SPC (Super Physical Contact), FC/UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) for low insertion loss and minimal back-reflection .
- Locking Mechanism: Screw-threaded design prevents rotation and ensures a stable connection
