- **ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) Cables:** These cables are self-supporting and do not rely on a messenger wire. Anchor clamps for ADSS cables are made from non-conductive materials to prevent electrical interference and are designed to handle the full tensile load of the cable
