A ceramic insert is most likely made of porcelain if it is smooth, translucent, and fired at high temperatures, whereas earthenware is more porous, opaque, and fired at lower temperatures.

Key Differences Between Earthenware and Porcelain

Earthenware is a low-fire ceramic, typically fired between 1,830–1,940°F (cone 04-06), and remains porous with 10–15% water absorption unless glazed. It has a warm, earthy tone, a matte or rustic finish, and is relatively fragile, making it more suitable for decorative or casual use rather than high-stress applications. Porcelain, on the other hand, is made from fine kaolin clay combined with feldspar and silica, fired at very high temperatures of 2,280–2,420°F (cone 8-12). This results in a fully vitrified, nonporous, and highly durable material with a smooth, glossy surface and often a translucent appearance. Porcelain is ideal for functional inserts, tableware, and applications requiring strength and elegance.

How to Identify the Material

- **Translucency:** Hold the insert up to light; porcelain often allows light to pass through thin sections, while earthenware does not.
- **Surface and Finish:** Porcelain is smooth and glossy; earthenware is more textured and matte.
- **Weight and Density:** Porcelain is denser and feels lighter relative to its thickness,...
