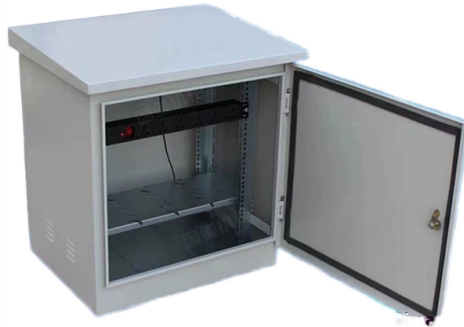


Is the core switch a type of server

- **Redundancy and Reliability:** Core switches often include dual power supplies, hot-swappable modules, and link aggregation to maintain continuous network operation .
- **Centralized Traffic Management:** They serve as the backbone of enterprise networks, connecting multiple distribution switches and ensuring smooth communication across departments or data centers .
