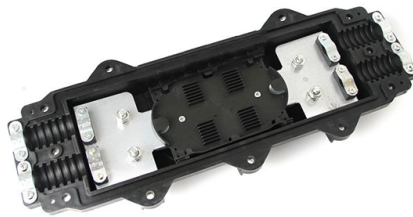


Is the switch connected to a fiber optic cable
