

Loss of 200 meters of drop fiber optic cable



Article Overview

The expected optical loss for 200 meters of fiber optic cable is approximately 0.1 dB for singlemode fiber and 0.2–0.3 dB for multimode fiber, excluding connectors or splices.

Fiber Attenuation

The loss in fiber optic cables is primarily due to attenuation, which depends on fiber type and wavelength. For singlemode fiber:

- At 1310 nm, typical attenuation is about 0.5 dB/km, which translates to roughly 0.1 dB for 200 meters .
- At 1550 nm, attenuation is slightly lower, around 0.4 dB/km, giving a similar or slightly smaller loss over 200 meters .

For multimode fiber:

- At 850 nm, attenuation is about 3 dB/km, resulting in approximately 0.6 dB for 200 meters.
- At 1300 nm, attenuation is about 1 dB/km, giving roughly 0.2 dB for 200 meters .
