Key Passive Components

Optical Splitters and Couplers: These devices divide or combine optical signals with minimal insertion loss, enabling efficient signal distribution in PON, FTTH, and MAN deployments. Splitters are essential for high split ratios (e.g., 1:32 or 1:64) to maximize network coverage while maintaining signal integrity. Couplers allow bidirectional signal sharing and monitoring in complex network topologies.

Wavelength Division Multiplexers (WDMs): WDM devices, including DWDM and CWDM modules, allow multiple wavelengths to share a single fiber, increasing bandwidth without additional fiber deployment. They are critical for 5G fronthaul, metro, and long-haul networks.

Connectors and MPO/MT Ferrules: High-density MPO connectors support multi-fiber termination (up to 72 fibers) and parallel optics, reducing space and insertion loss in dense urban networks. SC connectors are suitable for single-fiber terminations with reliable low-loss performance.

Attenuators, Isolators, and Circulators: These components manage signal power, prevent back-reflection, and maintain signal quality over long distances, ensuring stable operation in metropolitan networks.
