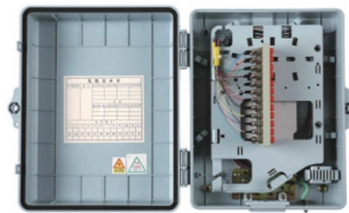

The main cabling ratio refers to the number of output fibers served by a single input fiber. Common ratios include:

- 1:2 - One input fiber splits into two output fibers, suitable for small-scale deployments or short-distance connections .
- 1:4 - One input fiber splits into four output fibers, often used in medium-density FTTx networks .
- 1:8 - One input fiber splits into eight output fibers, common in residential or multi-dwelling unit (MDU) networks .
- 1:16 to 1:32 - Higher-density splitting for large-scale deployments, allowing a single feeder fiber to serve many subscribers . These ratios are typically implemented usi...
