

Measurement of cable tray support position



Overview

Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while heavy-duty, long-span trays can handle distances of up to 20 feet between supports. To determine the proper spacing, consult the manufacturer's load capacity chart, which accounts for the total weight of the.
