Use Non-Conductive Tools: Use fiberglass or wooden ladders, scaffolding, and non-metallic tools to avoid electrical contact. Assess the Work Area: Always check for nearby powerlines and ensure equipment stays clear of danger zones. In Construction – Lorry mounted cranes (such as Hiabs or Palingers), Mobile Elevated Work Platforms (MEWP's), scaffold poles, tipper vehicles, cranes, ladders; In Agriculture – combines, sprayer booms, materials handlers, tipper vehicles, ladders, irrigation pipes, polytunnels; Remember: going.
