

Method for making a fiber optic tray



Article Overview

Preparing a fiber optic tray involves organizing, cleaning, cleaving, splicing, and securing fibers to ensure low-loss, reliable network connections.

Tools and Safety

Before starting, gather essential tools: fiber optic strippers, precision cleavers, fusion or mechanical splicers, heat shrink sleeves, lint-free wipes, isopropyl alcohol, safety glasses, and proper labeling materials . Ensure the workspace is well-lit and free of dust. Handle fibers carefully, as broken strands can cause injury, and dispose of scraps in designated containers .

Step-by-Step Preparation

1. Cable Stripping: Use fiber optic strippers to remove the outer jacket of the cable, exposing the inner fibers without damaging them . 2. Buffer Tube Removal: Carefully cut away buffer tubes to access individual fibers. Avoid microbends or breaks during this step . 3. Cleaning Fibers: Clean each fiber with alcohol wipes and lint-free cloths to remove dust, oils, or debris, which can affect splice quality . 4. Cleaving Fibers: Use a precision cleaver to cut the fiber ends at a perfect right angle. A clean cleave is critical for low-loss splicing . 5. Splicing Fibers:

- Fusion Splicing: Align fibers in a fusion splicer and weld them together for a permanent, low-loss connection .
- Mechanical Splicing: Align fibers using a mechanical splice connector for faster installation without welding .
- 6. Splice Protection: Cover the splice with a heat shrink...
