Article Overview

Mozambique hosts multiple submarine fiber optic cables, including SEACOM, EASSy, and 2Africa, with key landing points in Maputo and Nacala, enhancing national and international connectivity.

Submarine Cable Infrastructure

Mozambique has three major international submarine cables: SEACOM (2009), EASSy (2010), and 2Africa (2023). SEACOM and EASSy land in Maputo, while 2Africa lands in both Maputo and Nacala, marking the first submarine cable landing in northern Mozambique. These cables connect Mozambique to Europe, Africa, and Asia, providing high-capacity, low-latency internet access and supporting the country's growing digital economy.

Operators and Infrastructure

The main operators managing Mozambique's fiber optic infrastructure are Telecomunicações de Moçambique (TDM), Vodacom, and Movitel. TDM, part of Mozambique Telecom (Tmcel), is state-owned and controls most access to subsea cable landings. Vodacom is the designated partner for the 2Africa cable, providing infrastructure for cable installation at the iColo MPM1 data center in Maputo and the Nacala Cable Landing Station. These operators maintain terrestrial fiber backbones that connect the landing stations to domestic networks.
