- **Spacing Between Bends:** Avoid placing bends too close together. Adequate straight sections between bends allow cables to transition smoothly and reduce mechanical stress .
- **Support and Alignment:** Secure the cable tray to the supporting structure at regular intervals to prevent sagging or misalignment, which can increase stress at bends .
- **Cable Bundling:** When routing multiple cables through bends, bundle them carefully to prevent overcrowding. Overfilled trays can lead to overheating and difficulty in maintenance
