

Neutral line in the distribution box



Article Overview

The neutral line in a distribution box provides the essential return path for electrical current, completing the circuit and maintaining a zero-voltage reference relative to the ground.

Function of the Neutral Line

The neutral line carries current back to the power source after it has passed through a load, such as lights or appliances, ensuring the circuit is complete and functional . It is maintained at or near zero volts relative to the earth, which establishes a reference point for standard 120V or 230V circuits . Unlike the ground wire, which is primarily for safety, the neutral line actively carries current during normal operation .

Placement in the Distribution Box

In a typical distribution box, the neutral line is connected to a neutral bus bar (often marked as N), which collects return conductors from all branch circuits . Single-pole breakers connect the hot line to the load while the neutral wire connects directly to the neutral bar. In two-pole breakers, both the hot and neutral lines may be disconnected simultaneously for enhanced safety during maintenance . The neutral bus is often located alongside the ground bus, but the two are distinct, with the neutral sometimes bonded to ground at the main service panel to limit voltage differences .
