

No signal when fiber optic cable is plugged into router

No signal when connecting a fiber optic cable to a router is often caused by hardware issues, incorrect configuration, or missing Optical Network Terminal (ONT) setup.

Check the Fiber Connection and Hardware

Ensure the fiber cable is properly connected to the ONT or the router's fiber port. Most residential fiber setups require an ONT provided by your ISP, which converts optical signals into electrical signals your router can use. Verify that the fiber cable is not damaged, bent sharply, or contaminated; even small dust particles on connectors can block the signal. Clean connectors with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol if necessary.

Verify Router and ONT Compatibility

Not all routers support direct fiber input. Check that your router has a fiber-ready port (SFP or WAN labeled for fiber) and supports the speed of your fiber connection. If your router requires an Ethernet connection from the ONT, ensure you are using a high-quality Cat6a or higher Ethernet cable.

Power and Indicator Lights

Power on the ONT first and wait for its status lights to stabilize (usually 2-5 minutes). Then power on the router and check the indicator lights. A "LOS" (Loss of Signal) LE...
