ODF patch panels come in several types, including rack-mounted, wall-mounted, modular, sliding drawer, and high-density MPO/MTP panels, each designed for specific fiber management needs.

Rack-Mount ODF Patch Panels

Rack-mounted ODFs are the most common type, typically installed in 19-inch or 23-inch racks in data centers or telecom rooms. They provide high fiber capacity, often supporting hundreds to thousands of fibers, and include modular patch panels for cross-connecting fibers, splice trays for fusion or mechanical splicing, and cable management accessories for organized routing .

Wall-Mount ODF Patch Panels

Wall-mounted ODFs are compact units suitable for small telecom rooms, server closets, or distributed installations. They handle lower fiber counts, usually 12-96 fibers, and are ideal where space is limited. These panels provide basic protection and structured routing for terminated fibers .

Modular ODF Patch Panels

Modular ODFs allow scalable expansion by adding or replacing patch panels or cassettes as fiber counts grow. They are designed for flexible deployment, enabling quick adaptation to network upgrades or increased traffic demands. Modular designs often support both single-mode and multi-mode fibers
