OEM (Brand New) Optical Modules

OEM transceivers are produced or branded by the original networking equipment manufacturer, such as Cisco, Juniper, Arista, or HPE. These modules are designed specifically for the vendor's hardware and are sold under their brand name. Key characteristics include:

- **Guaranteed Compatibility:** Fully compatible with the vendor's switches and routers, with no recognition or performance issues .
- **Stability and Reliability:** Undergo rigorous testing and validation to ensure long-term operation under heavy loads .
- **Technical Support and Warranty:** Covered by the manufacturer's official warranty and support services .
- **High Cost:** Typically several times more expensive than compatible modules due to branding and R&D cost recovery, sometimes marking up 300% to 1000% .
- **Vendor Lock-In:** Limits flexibility by tying the network to a single vendor ecosystem .
