Construction: These cables typically consist of optical fibers housed in loose tubes made of high-modulus plastics, filled with thixotropic jelly, and stranded around a central strength member. The core is covered with water-blocking tape and yarns, followed by a PE inner sheath and an anti-rodent PE jacket for protection against mechanical damage and pests (Premier Cables) . **Reinforcement Materials:**

- **FRP (Fiber Reinforced Plastic):** Provides mechanical strength without electrical conductivity, making it suitable for lightning-prone areas. It is lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and does not generate induction currents, allowing installation near high-voltage lines .
- **Aramid (Kevlar/Twaron):** High-strength, high-modulus fibers with excellent thermal and oxidation resistance, commonly used in ADSS cables for self-supporting applications .
- **Glass Fiber Yarn:** Offers high tensile strength, insulation, and corrosion resistance, ideal for wet or high-voltage environments . **Advantages:**
