Article Overview

Modifying an electrical distribution box in Portugal requires compliance with RTIEBT standards, proper protective devices, and adherence to municipal and DSO regulations.

Regulatory Compliance

Any modification to a low-voltage distribution box in Portugal must comply with the Regras Técnicas das Instalações Elétricas de Baixa Tensão (RTIEBT), currently governed by Portaria n.º 949-A/2006 with subsequent amendments . This ensures safety, efficiency, and legal conformity. Key requirements include:

- Certification and qualified personnel: Only certified electricians can perform modifications, and all work must be documented with updated schematics, descriptive reports, and test results .
- Protective devices: Coordination between circuit breakers, fuses, and residual current devices (e.g., 30 mA in wet areas) is mandatory .
- Earthing systems: Proper TT, TN, or IT grounding with measured and valid resistance is required .
- Inspection and maintenance: Functional and documentary verification, including preventive maintenance of connections, insulation, surge protection, and differential devices, is essential .
