

Power outage at the distribution box switch pulled

If a power outage occurs due to a pulled switch at the distribution box, first check your internal breakers and RCDs, then safely reset the main switch or ICP, and call a qualified electrician if the problem persists.

Immediate Steps to Take

- **Check the Electrical Panel** Inspect your home or business electrical panel to see if any circuit breakers or residual current devices (RCDs) have tripped. Circuit breakers trip when too much power is drawn or a short circuit occurs, while RCDs trip if current leaks to the ground, often in wet areas like kitchens or bathrooms .
- **Unplug Devices** Before resetting any tripped switch, unplug all devices connected to the affected circuits. This prevents immediate retripping and helps identify if a specific appliance is causing the fault .
- **Reset the Switch**
 - For a circuit breaker or RCD, flip the switch back to the "On" position.
 - If the main power control switch (ICP) has tripped, turn off the main switch in your home, wait about 3 seconds, and turn it back on .
- **Check Neighbors and External Supply** If your neighbors also have no power, the issue may be with the distribution network, not your internal wiring. In this case, contact your Distribution Network Operator (DNO) or call the emergency number 105 in the UK .
