

Primary optical cable line length and height adjustment



Article Overview

Proper line length and height adjustment of optical cables ensure safe sag, tension, and mechanical integrity during installation.

Determining Cable Line Length

The line length of a primary optical cable is determined by the distance between support structures (poles or towers) and the total route length. Each span must account for:

- Sag and tension: The cable must hang with a controlled sag to prevent excessive tension or contact with the ground or obstacles. Sag is influenced by cable weight, span length, temperature, and wind load .
- Pre-reserved joints: The cable length should include extra length for splicing points and maintenance loops .
- Mechanical limits: Maximum pulling tension and crush resistance must not be exceeded. For OSP loose tube or ribbon cables, typical maximum pulling tension is around 600 lbf, and short-term crush should not exceed 125 lbf per linear inch .
