IP ratings focus on dust and water ingress, NEMA types cover broader environmental conditions, IK ratings measure impact resistance, and UL or CSA certifications. 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The Level of Protection & corresponding Equipment Protection Level associated with Flameproof Enclosures (d) are as follows: Level of Protection da (EPL "Ma" or "Ga")

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Level 3 protection is the final barrier of the system, capable of fully eliminating any transient overvoltage that may occur, ensuring the long-term stable operation of sensitive equipment.
